Bridging College to Career: The Nursing EDGE Journey

The Nursing EDGE program continues to empower final-year nursing students with the skills to step confidently into clinical practice.
Through immersive bedside training, soft skills workshops, and job readiness modules, students are gaining not just knowledge, but the confidence to excel in fast-paced healthcare environments.



Students describe the program as "transformative," equipping them with communication skills, workplace professionalism, and the confidence to care for patients with compassion and competence. Hospitals too are seeing the benefits: a workforce better prepared for the realities of modern healthcare.

DEPLOYMENTS

International and Domestic

During the first half of 2025, GWD made significant strides in strengthening healthcare systems both internationally and within India. Across the globe, 59 healthcare professionals were positioned in the United Kingdom with valued partners such as CDC, Capital Nurse, and Ramsay Health, while 110 talented individuals found placements in the Middle East, serving institutions such as HMG Al-Habib and Dr. Abdulaziz Alajaji Dental.

Domestically, GWD bolstered India's healthcare workforce by placing 665 professionals within the Apollo Group, including AHEL, Apollo Homecare, and new hospitals in Athena and Pune, and an additional 8 specialists with non-Apollo organizations.

Residential OSCE Training Programme Launched at Crewe Campus

AEUK has introduced a new residential training programme at the Crewe Campus to support international nurses in successfully clearing the Nursing and Midwifery Council's Objective Structured Clinical Examination (NMC OSCE).



The programme covers both Adult and Mental Health OSCE exams and is designed with comprehensive support, including accommodation and pastoral care, ensuring candidates are well-prepared for success.

This initiative is delivered in collaboration with Ealoor Consultancy UK Ltd, an NMC-approved OSCE training provider since 2015, bringing proven expertise to the programme.

The launch event was attended by Mayor Dawn Clarke and MP Connor Naismith, whose presence highlighted the significance of this step in strengthening the global healthcare workforce.

International Collaboration with Derbyshire Healthcare NHS Foundation Trust

AEUK, in collaboration with Derbyshire Healthcare NHS Foundation Trust, has supported the recruitment of 14 psychiatrists from India to strengthen the Trust's workforce.



As part of this initiative, the AEUK team recently visited India to:

- Connect with Apollo Institutes and Colleges on potential areas of collaboration and professional development.
- Engage with Apollo Hospitals leadership to gain deeper insights into India's expanding medical talent pool.

2+2 Indo-UK Medical Residency Program

Advanced Certification in Genomics

Global Workforce Development, in collaboration with Sri Ramachandra Institute of Higher Education and Research, proudly announces the launch of the Advanced Certification in Genomics (ACG), a one-year, full-time program starting August 2025 at the SRIHER campus in Chennai.



This program aims to bridge the global talent gap in Clinical Genomics by preparing the next generation of Clinical Scientists through internationally aligned training, including:

- Hands-on training by national and international experts
- English language and soft skills development
- Interview readiness for roles within the NHS and other global healthcare systems

Aligned with the UK's NHS curriculum, the ACG program covers Genetic Testing, Bioinformatics, Genomic Medicine, Prenatal/Pediatric/Adult Genomics, and Genomic Counselling.

Global Healthcare Recruitment Opportunities Across Borders

At Apollo, we are committed to helping healthcare professionals explore rewarding careers around the world. Our upcoming recruitment plans span multiple countries, specialties, and pathways - offering tailored opportunities that meet both professional goals and personal aspirations.

Nursing Careers in Saudi Arabia – Interviews Weekly and Quarterly

We are gearing up to support bedside nurses from any department in Saudi Arabia through online interviews, conducted weekly for BSc nurses (with at least 1 year of experience) and GNM nurses (with 2+ years of experience). Preference will be given to candidates who have cleared the Prometric exam for faster deployment.

Additionally, private hospital interviews will be held both online and face-to-face every three months in key locations such as Kashmir, Guwahati, Delhi, Hyderabad, Bengaluru, Kochi, and Kottayam. Deployments are expected within 2–3 months, offering candidates with excellent communication and professionalism a chance to be part of transformative healthcare initiatives.

Radiographers in the United Kingdom – NHS Opportunities

In collaboration with NHS employers, we are inviting applications from HCPC registered radiographers with IELTS scores of 6.5 or higher (ideally 7.0+). With at least three years of experience in reputed healthcare facilities, candidates will be positioned for roles that not only leverage their expertise but also contribute to the long-term sustainability of healthcare services in the UK.

Germany – Nursing Pathways with Language Training Support

For fresh graduates and final-year students, we offer a structured 7-month language training program designed to take participants to B2 proficiency, followed by interviews with hospitals and care homes. Successful candidates can expect deployment within 3–4 months post-training.

For experienced nurses already holding B1 certification, we provide pathways to complete B2 proficiency and support with necessary documentation, aiming for deployment within 2–3 months after the training is complete.



Australia – AHPRA-Registered Nursing Pathways

Indian nurses with 3+ years of acute/surgical experience, or 4+ years in ICU, emergency, perioperative, or radiology roles, can access programs designed to transition them into fully registered positions. Candidates will work as assistant nurses during the registration process before moving into licensed roles.

We are also welcoming applications from nurses in the UK, Ireland, and New Zealand with 2–3 years of experience, who have completed AHPRA and ANMAC certification requirements, with demand-based interviews organized with leading hospitals.

New Zealand – Specialist Doctor Recruitment

We are expanding our focus to recruit experienced doctors in specialties such as anaesthetics, radiology, psychiatry, emergency medicine, acute medicine, neurology, and oncology.

With over three years of experience and recognized certifications such as EDAIC, FRCA, FRCR, MRCPsych, and MRCEM, candidates from Australia, Austria, Belgium, Canada, Chile, and other eligible countries will have access to career-advancing opportunities.
